Here at Kiddie Prep School our classrooms use something called  
***“The Creative Curriculum”***.

The Creative Curriculum for Preschool is one of the most widely used Pre-K curricula in the nation. It’s research-based, comprehensive, and it features exploration and discovery as a way of learning.

In this week’s video, 3 year olds are exploring their imaginations, fine motor skills, and engineering as they build with Legos. They then expand in their play and have a story line to go with one another’s creations as they interact and work with one another as they build and play.

Pre K students are seen working on their mathematic skills through number counting, symbol recognition, and fine motor skills in the same center.

Other Pre K students work on cause and effect questions while also showing their color identification knowledge and interacting with peers through taking turns.
