

Kiddie Prep School: School Age Student Fee Information

Effective Date: February 9, 2023

In order to be enrolled in our summer school age program, your child must have completed kindergarten.

We will be closed December 25, 2023 through January 1, 2024.

MISCELLANEOUS FEES and CHARGES

PAYMENTS & CARD TRANSACTION FEES: REQUIRED FORM OF PAYMENT is automatic batch payments from a linked checking or savings account. A major credit card or debit card may be linked for batch payments; however, there is a variable percentage fee per transaction.

Returned Check Fee: \$25.00

School Age ANNUAL Registration Fee: \$75 per child for summer and \$25 for Christmas break. Maximum fee of \$200 per family. This is a non-refundable fee. This fee is due prior to attending each year. SA families cannot attend without a paid registration fee. Full-time or part-time must be designated at registration.

Early disenrollment policy: If a student does not attend or disenrolls prior to the end of the program, the 2-day minimum will be charged for weeks the child does not attend after the one vacation hold fee is used.

Finance Fee: \$30.00 per week late fee for a delinquent account. Being two-weeks behind risks immediate disenrollment.

Vacation Hold Fee: There is **ONE \$100/week (M-F)** holding fees for school age children.

LATE Pick-up Fee: \$15.00 for the first 10 minutes past 6:00pm. Additional \$1 for every minute after 6:10pm. Upon the third late pick-up, this fee is increased to \$25 for the first 10 minutes past 6:00pm. Additional \$1 for every minute after 6:10pm. The late pick-up fee is **per child**.

Vouchers: Any fees or tuition charges not received by agencies for those on vouchers, are the responsibility of the parent/guardian and will be batched from their linked bank account/credit card. If documentation requirements are not met weekly, the outstanding balance will be transferred to the parent/guardian and the child may be disenrolled.

Drop-in service is not available: KPS is NOT open for drop-in services for school age children throughout the school year.
